**54/2016 PETER FOX – PRESENTATION REGARDING VENDING
MACHINES**

There was a meeting a few weeks ago, and thanks must go to Margaret Strange who attended the meeting and brought some literature about vending machines. Peter started a business a few years ago, where village who do not have shop could have a large vending machine, he designed the machine, and put a shop into Kniveton near Ashbourne, which took off, he now had 7 halls of residence at University of Derby. He had contacted DCC and DCCC and communities can access government funding for a 'village shop', all that is needed is a site and an electricity supply. Advice can be gained through Rural Action Derbyshire – Village SOS. Vending machines do not need planning permission but a licence may required for equipment adjacent to the highway.
