A lady once again spoke about Whitworth hospital and the closure of Oaker Ward, which has just been refurbished, and the League of Friends bought the beds for the ward initially. When the ward closes there will be 1 bed available for Accident & Emergency, which might then mean that A & E will close. Most of the money seems to be going to Dementia, Alzheimers and Mental Health patients, other patients with physical illness do not appear to be getting the care that they need in their own homes.

There had been a recent consultation meeting about the closure, and questions had been put to the Finance Officer who could not answer them.

The Parish Council has written against the closure already, however the lady did ask that everyone should be encouraged to attend the march which has been arranged for next Saturday.
