SUB COMMITTEE MEETINGS OF COUNCILLORS HELD ON SITE DURING COVID LOCKDOWN PERIOD

OCTOBER 2020 FETE FIELD MOWER STORE

Cllrs Neville, Toplis & Fete Field Committee discussed the requirements for the mower store.
DECISION: Builder to provide quote for work to be carried out and brought to full council for ratification of the amount to be paid by the Parish Council.

OCTOBER 2020 COMMUNITY HALL

Cllrs Raynes, Strange, Gray, Lane & Taylor met with the preferred contractors at the hall following the meeting and went through the Parish Council requirements for the hall.

NOVEMBER 2020 THE ROPEWALK

Cllrs Raynes, Strange, Smith & Hopkinson met with Patrick Mountain DCC Rights of Way. Concerns have been raised about fly tipping on the Right of Way. DCC have issued a legal warning to a resident requesting the removal of obstruction
Patrick Mountain said that DCC would reinstate Footpath 2 to include additional drainage. The new drain would go into the main drain on Green Lane. Councillors raised concerns about the concrete pathway onto the Fete Field which has become eroded by excess surface water and is in a dangerous condition.
DECISION to be acted upon by the Chair & Vice Chair: Councillors were happy that DCC are going down the legal route and the repairs requested are to be carried out by DCC.

NOVEMBER 2020 COMMUNITY HALL

Cllrs Raynes, Strange, Gray, Lane & Taylor met with CMC providers of the new door, regarding the style and fitting etc.
DECISION to be acted upon by the Chair & Vice Chair: That the door be as discussed within the Parish Council earlier, with a glass panel to help with health & safety issues regarding the door opening inwards to the hall.

MARCH 2021 THE ROPEWALK

Cllrs Raynes, Strange, Smith & Hopkinson meet to discuss building the boundary wall, and the drainage issues, to request a price for the work.
DECISION to be acted upon by the Chair & Vice Chair: All suggested works ratified by Councillors' present.

APRIL 2021 THE FETE FIELD

Cllrs Raynes, Strange, Neville & Toplis met individually to discuss works to the mower store and the delay in the delivery of the roller shutter door.
DECISION to be acted upon by the Chair & Vice Chair: To leave the Heras fencing in situ for the present time, and the spoil from the build to be removed as soon as there is an improvement in the weather.

APRIL 2021 COMMUNITY HALL

Cllrs Raynes, Strange, Lane & Taylor met to consider the water damage to the building through the roof, met with Dave Watts contractor from the village,.
DECISION to be acted upon by the Chair & Vice Chair: To replace the lead valley as an emergency measure and Cllr Taylor to prepare a report to Full Council in May considering the sum involved which could be in excess of £10K.

NOVEMBER 2020 To APRIL 2021 KNABB HALL LANE TRAVELLER SITE

Cllrs Raynes and Strange and the Clerk have met regularly throughout this period to consider the developments of the Knabb Hall site and instruct Solicitors on the way forward.
