Results from Village Questionnaire concerning Housing Development in Draft Proposal from DDDC

14th July 2010

We posted out 480 questionnaires. There were 174 responses (36% return). There were 121 written comments from village residents. These are on the the copies of the returns, provided to Derbyshire Dales District Council. Please note that these were given out on a household, not an individual basis; and so most reurns are actually an agreed response from two residents. The views of the village concerning the size of any proposed future development are clear. Any development in Tansley should be small-scale, and scattered. Even regarded over the time of the plan, residents' views of what should be an acceptable total fall sharply after 15 new households; and many believe that there should be no development whatsoever. There is a very strong feeling that development will proceed regardless of community concerns.

Note: The phrases such as 'affordable', 'social housing' and 'local need' in draft documents are open to varied interpretations and should be replaced in future with more specific terms.
